

Fellowship Opportunity

The Center for Spirituality & Practice and The Fetzer Institute

The Practicing Democracy Project Fellowship is an eight-month opportunity for graduate students and post grads interested in exploring how democracy as a way of life can be strengthened and deepened through spiritual practices. Three Fellows each year will work with The Center for Spirituality & Practice and the Fetzer Institute, collaborators on the Project, to craft their involvement, based upon their skills and interests, in a wide-ranging effort to help shape America's democracy for the common good of all.

Areas of concentration could be identifying and testing spiritual practices; writing and curating relevant resources for the website PracticingDemocracy.net; creating program plans for individual and group use; outreach to determine needs of various constituencies across the political spectrum; and developing a publicity/promotion and social media campaign for the Project.

Fellows will be candidates for Ph.D., D.Min., M.Div., and M.A. degrees as well as Post-Grads in the fields of Religion and Spirituality, Education, Cultural Studies, Politics, Government, Public Policy, Marketing, Communication, and Journalism. Fellows will attend regular mentoring and sharing sessions (in person or via Zoom) with the Spirituality & Practice team. Those in the Claremont, California, area will have access to the large library of spiritual resources at the Center. (Please note: Because of a planned training session in California, we are only reviewing applications from U.S. residents.)

Fellowships begin in February/March 2019 and continue through September/October 2019. Fellows will receive a \$13,000 stipend for 520 hours of work (schedule to be negotiated).
